The Steven J. Green School of International and Public Affairs will support graduate travel on a matching basis. The Green School will award up to \$200 once a year to encourage graduate students to present their research at professional meetings, to defray travel expenses associated with research, or to interview for a job.

I. Criteria

- A. Academic Status
 - 1. students must have a minimum GPA of 3.0
 - 2. student must be a registered full-time student
- B. Purpose of Travel
 - 1. To present a research paper at a professional meeting
 - 2. To support travel to research sites
 - 3. Interview for academic positions

II. Procedures

- A. Complete and print the application form (typeable PDF)
- B. Obtain a memo of support from the Major Professor
- C. Provide a copy of current unofficial transcript
- D. Provide a copy of TAR
- E. Get signatures from the Graduate Program Director & Department Chair
- F. Submit items A-E to the Green School Dean's Office (SIPA 525)
 - 4 weeks prior to travel

III. Limitations

A. The Green School will provide up to \$200/student/year
